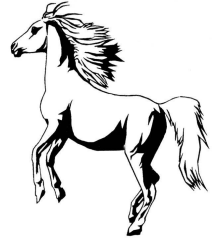


AMELIASBURGH FAIR HORSE & PONY SHOW

Rules for exhibiting:

1. Paid-up Fair membership of \$5.00 for all participants. Gate fee of \$5.00 applies to all non-members attending.
2. Pony class equines must be 14.2 hands and under.
3. Classes will be run according to AQHA rules and Judges' interpretation will govern.
4. Approved riding helmets are required for all riders under 19 years of age.



Divisions

Youth Exhibitor – 18 years and under as of January 1, 2018

Senior Exhibitor – 19 years and over as of January 1, 2018.

Pony Exhibitor – 16 years and under as of January 1, 2018.

Junior Horse – horse to be 5 years of age or under as of January 1, 2018.

Walk/Jog – closed riding classes open to youth riders with limited experience.
